Terving, most often starts from  $\mathcal N$  being served, that is what happened often in nursery. Most people : feel anxious because they do not have experience on caring any children of this age. It is true that children under age of two are very dependent on their mothers. Other than the needs to develop on independence, their daily schedule also keeps changing, both on diet and resting schedule. As a result, most of the serving teachers in nursery are mothers who has experience on raising young children. These teachers have served for years. Even though their own children have grown up, they are still willing to serve these little, but very challenging, babies. This serving heart touches a lot of first time visiting mothers.

When I visited the nursey for the first time, I admired and felt at ease when seeing the teachers clean the toys, arrange snacks, change diapers, as well as give hugs and comfort to the young children, without showing they are troubled or bothered. Ăs a new mother, I was anxious to separate with my young child, how-ever, knowing the teachers are experienced and responsible, I did not have any hesitation they would take care my child while I went to worship. Based on the precious time I experienced, it motivates me to serve in nursery, so other mothers have an opportunity to worship, without worrying their children. Also, by serving in nursery, I am able to observe different personalities on children which benefits me on learning how to raise my child by knowing my child better.

As a new mother, nursery is a good place to get advices from other parents, especially on how to raise a child, plus giving the child an opportunity to interact with similar age children. Many mothers make friends who care each other, also learning

each stage of development and loving all babies with different personalities through nursery. Based on these, a lot of mothers are willing to participate in this service. beautiful Sometimes there are some mothers who are seekers, because they have a good relationship with mothers who are believers, they are more willing to know Christianity more.
