2. Church Re-Opening - RCCC is now in Stage 2 reopening for in-person services as of June 1, 2021. Stage 2 includes ALL people (vaccinated and unvaccinated) who follow the same safety procedures set forth in Stage 1. People who are properly wearing face masks can attend in-person worship service and other meetings. (See details below) The reopening date for the Cantonese service will be announced separately. In addition, in-person Sunday school, small group fellowship, youth and children's activities, etc., can also begin when the team responsible for the ministry deemed they are ready. 4. **Voting** - The Church will have a special congregational meeting on August 8th for the voting of new deacons with a one time term exception proposal. Because the pandemic concern still exists, it will be difficult for everyone to meet in-person as a congregation so the Church Council has elected the similar approach as last year to allow a 5 day voting time frame from August 4th to August 8th (Wednesday– Friday: 10am-1pm; Saturday: 10am-4pm; Sunday: 9pm-1pm). Members can cast their vote in person at the Church or vote by proxy (authorizing another member to vote for you).
