

RCCC Dress Guidelines

At RCCC, we want to promote a Christ-like atmosphere where we have godly respect for one another. We would like to have an atmosphere at church that is free from all distractions so that we can all focus on Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Our dress guidelines have always been to dress in a way that would be honoring to Jesus Christ, but some have asked for further clarification. To that end, we offer the following guidelines.

- Please wear modest shorts, dresses, skirts, pants, and/or jeans. The length of your clothes should be longer than when your hand is extended straight on your side. Excessively short and tight-fitting clothes are not appropriate.
- Please wear appropriate shirts, t-shirts, and blouses. Spaghetti straps (for women) and tank straps (for men and women) are not acceptable. Also, midriffs and tank tops are not acceptable.
- Please also refrain from wearing any kind of shirt or t-shirt that promotes alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, and secular music groups. Also, please refrain from wearing shirts or t-shirts that explicitly or implicitly promote racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person. And, finally, please refrain from any shirt or t-shirt that explicitly or implicitly focuses on the physical anatomy of males or females.
- Males are also asked to not wear any shorts or pants that sag and call attention to their underwear.
- Appropriate shoes for church and church activities.

We hope that these suggested guidelines will help in the clarification of what is appropriate and respectful to wear not only to church, but in everyday life. As you pray and ask the Lord about your style and manner of clothing, He will give you clear guidance and insight as to what is honoring to Him.
